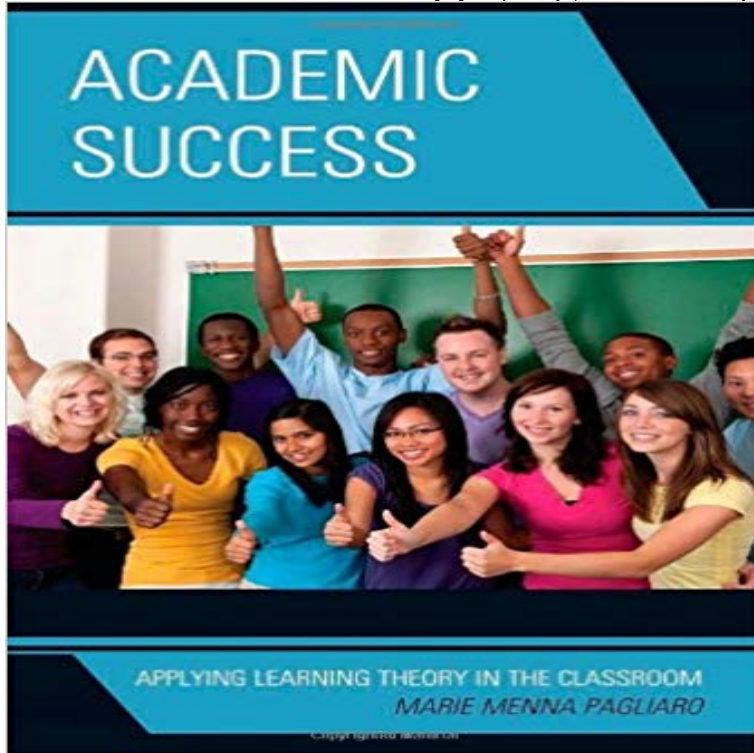


Academic Success: Applying Learning Theory in the Classroom
