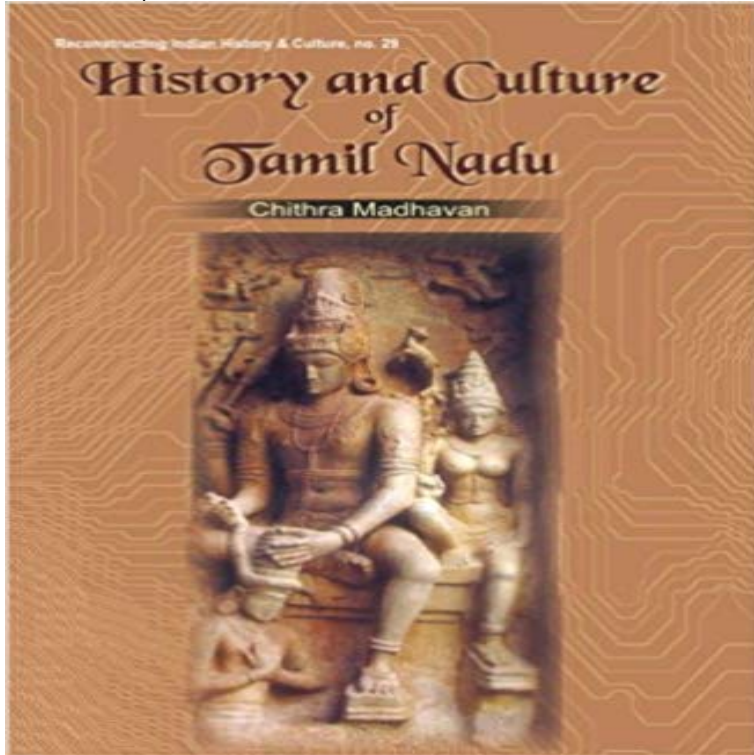


History and Culture of Tamil Nadu Volume one up to AD 1310
